Timber Lines Transportation Service is a recognized community leader in the promotion of specialized services for people with disabilities and older adults. Services are provided throughout the City of Wichita and some surrounding county areas. Timber Lines takes great pride in serving its consumers with respect, concern, courtesy and responsiveness. As more people are able to live independently, transportation continues to be an essential element to their independence.

Since 1998, Timber Lines has served 1,000 people, provided more than 150,000 rides and driven well over a million miles. This has enabled people with disabilities and older adults to get out of their homes and into the community to enjoy recreational activities, go to work, keep medical appointments, attend school and more.

Timber Lines is also a vendor for the Sedgwick County Transportation Brokerage, which is a system that allows consumers to use a "one-phone-number" approach in scheduling a ride. The SCTB then assigns the ride to one of its vendors. This brokerage system has increased the overall availability of specialized transportation throughout the community.

Timber Lines is supported by several funding sources including, the City of Wichita, Sedgwick County, Medicaid, the Kansas Department of Transportation and other private donations from the community.

People that use wheelchairs and have a medical card, are now able to get accessible transportation to their medical appointments with no personal, out-of-pocket expense through Non-Emergency Medical Transportation.
