

It is my hope that the successes we have experienced in 2017 will continue for years to come.



It is hard to believe that 2017 was CPRF's 45th anniversary. The vision for CPRF grew from its founder (my father), "Jack" Jonas, who was challenged by a speech pathology client in the 1960s to do more for adults with disabilities. The client, Pat



Kraft, was frustrated that after all his hard work in speech and schooling, his only option was to go back home to live with his parents.

Pop took Pat's words to heart, and when he became Executive Director of United Cerebral Palsy of Kansas, my dad began a decades-long quest to provide greater opportunities for adults with disabilities. With the help of founding board members, early successes included creating a summer camp for people with disabilities, building an accessible urban residential facility, and (the highlight) passing legislation for special education services in Kansas three years prior to the federally-mandated system.

The Cerebral Palsy Research Foundation of Kansas grew out of UCP to allow more flexibility in program development and to satisfy the entrepreneurial spirit of the founder and board. We are tremendously grateful to

our exceptional board, our dedicated employees, and a slew of corporate, foundation, governmental, and individual supporters for their assistance in advancing our mission.

In 2018, we will be going full circle. Dave Jones, Executive Director of UCP, is retiring after nearly 40 years, and UCP's programs will be consolidated into CPRF. Our Adult Day Services team ensures that each client's individual needs are met every day. With amenities such as an accessible garden in our private courtyard, a wheelchair swing, sensory room, private swimming pool, community outings, and many other indoor learning and recreation opportunities, our clients have a variety of stimulating activities to choose from. We are able to offer these options thanks to the help of generous volunteers such as the Sedgwick County Master Gardeners, Wichita State University School of Music, United Way of the Plains, and many other community organizations. Caregivers can be confident that we provide their loved ones with excellent care.

ADULT DAY SERVICES

Our case managers coordinate services for more than 100 individuals with disabilities each year, focusing on advocacy, service provision, resources, funding, and helping clients understand their rights and responsibilities. We also offer the WORK Program through the State of Kansas, which is a service for individuals with disabilities who want to work, but still need to receive their vital health and long-term care coverage.

CASE MANAGEMENT

Our Wheelchair & Posture Seating Clinic addresses the needs of more than 780 adults and children with physical disabilities every year, building custom chairs that suit the needs and lifestyle of each individual. Designed to enhance comfort, provide better body alignment, and minimize the risk of pressure sores, our seating systems range from manual chairs to intricate power wheelchairs. Physical and Occupational Therapists are on-staff to work with each client to ensure that we build the best seating system possible. All of our wheelchair seating systems are built in-house by technicians with decades of specialized experience. Technicians and therapists work together to ensure each client receives the best chair for their optimal mobility, comfort, and independence.

WHEELCHAIR & POSTURE SEATING CLINIC




The CPRF Exercise and Wellness Program promotes physical fitness for people with disabilities through strength training, improving flexibility, and pain-controlling exercises. Our Certified Restorative Aide works with each client individually in our private gym on the Timbers campus. All exercise programs are written and prescribed for each client by an Occupational/Physical Therapist. Our equipment includes parallel bars, standing frames, hand cycles, a para-gym for wheelchair-accessible weight training, stretching mats, and our newest additions: elliptical and cardio strider.

EXERCISE & WELLNESS

KWIN provides Work Incentive Planning and Assistance services to Kansans with disabilities who want information about Social Security work incentives and community supports. In order to help people make informed employment decisions as they transition to and/or advance in employment, KWIN clients are offered guidance, benefit analysis, and a work incentive plan by Social Security Administration-certified Community Work Incentive Coordinators.

KANSAS WORK INCENTIVES NETWORK



The SACT is devoted to improving job-marketable skills for people with disabilities. In addition to our Microsoft-approved curriculum and Microsoft suite certifications, we offer courses in computing fundamentals and customer service. Our partnership with Workforce Alliance of South Central Kansas, USD 259, Mulvane School District, Haysville School District, and United Way of the Plains has allowed us to offer morning, afternoon, and summer classes for high school students with disabilities to learn valuable workplace skills and earn Microsoft certifications in Word and Excel while earning school credit. Since the program started in 2008, 313 students with disabilities have graduated from the program and 85% have passed at least one Microsoft Certification exam.

SCHOOL OF ADAPTIVE COMPUTER TRAINING



The Timbers is a 100-unit apartment community for people with physical disabilities, featuring roll-in showers, roll-under sinks and counters, accessible switches, and more. In addition to these amenities, the Timbers also has three FEMA tornado shelters throughout the campus for safety. Our wheelchair-friendly, open concept apartments and facilities make it possible for our residents to live life how they choose and to have a space that is all their own. Craft and book clubs, community guest speakers, and other engaging social activies allow residents to connect with each other. Timber Lines Transportation provides wheelchair-accessible rides to help residents and community members get to work, go grocery shopping, and keep appointments.

TIMBERS APARTMENTS & TRANSPORATION

Our Vocational Assessment team administers tests to measure aptitudes, skill levels, abilities, interests, work values, and more. The results generate a variety of potential careers and/or training programs that would suit the client. Our one-on-one approach ensures clients receive more precise employment recommendations, which can reduce job-related dissatisfaction and turnover rates.

The CPRF Job Placement department guides people with various vocational barriers to the right position through resume development, mock interviews, and application and job search assistance. Through Ticket to Work, End-Dependence Kansas, and other programs, we work with people individually to ensure they find a job that suits their career goals and abilities. Our staff further assists in the job hunt by educating clients on a potential employer's expectations, changes in the job market since they were last employed, and what to expect from the jobs they seek.

JOB PLACEMENT








People Served in 2017






Ethnicity






Primary Type of Disability*



LOGAN DAVIS

Logan was born with a condition called pulmonary stenosis, which is a cardiac defect. He also has Asperger's Syndrome; a form of Autism Spectrum Disorder, which is a condition characterized by persistent impairment in social interactions and by repetitive behavior patterns and restricted interests.

He participated in speech therapy throughout grade school and focused on learning social skills, facial expressions, and how to engage in reciprocal conversation.

It is difficult for Logan to write. In order to communicate by written word he has learned to use a computer and key board, which is not an easy task because the tendons in his fingers are tight and lack flexibility. In order to use a computer, Logan had to go through many hours of physical therapy, occupational therapy, and vision therapy.

Logan has extremely tight skin, with his sensory nerves very close to the surface of the skin, making it uncomfortable for him to be touched. While painless for the average person, a pat on the shoulder is uncomfortable and even painful for someone with Asperger's.

For many years, Logan participated in Special Olympics swimming, basketball, and summer events. While in high school, he was one of only 60 students selected from Kansas to attend the Robert J. Dole Institute for Political Leadership Camp. He also made the honor roll every year, was a member of the National Honor Society, and played soccer.

At his high school graduation he received, by unanimous faculty vote, the Outstanding Student in American History Award bestowed by the Daughters of the American Revolution.

He earned a full scholarship to Butler

Community College as a student worker in the Athletics Department, where he works as a statistician for soccer and basketball games. In this fast-paced position, he is required to remember a detailed list of tasks for each game.

demanding task that requires him to input information into a computer at the speed of the game."said Associate Athletic Director. He went on to explain that the other student workers consider Logan to be one of their leaders and they look up to him because of his knowledge and experience.

Logan will graduate from Butler Community College in the spring of 2018 and plans to pursue a degree in Sports Management at Wichita State University.

As his neighbor, a retired United States Air Force Colonel, shared in his recommendation letter, "Logan has maintained high academic achievements and with a chance to continue his education, his exceptional ability to remember and apply facts and details will be a positive factor in his future."

According to his grandmother, Logan is a remarkable young man who sets daily goals as well as life goals. He has accomplished things the average person his age has not. He is hard-working, thoughtful, and considerate.

Surrounded by his family, friends, and the whole CPRF team, Jacob received a check for \$1,000 at an awards banquet.


